

Dear Friends,

The Learning Project's 50th anniversary was, by all measures, a tremendous success! Throughout the year, our LPers enjoyed a series of events to mark the school's special birthday. The festivities culminated in our gala last May, with current and alumni LP families, Board members, faculty, staff, and other friends and supporters reunited and united to celebrate this momentous occasion – and to give Michael and Elisabeth McCord their own, long overdue "graduation" ceremony.

Once again, our extended LP community has supported the school at a level that is truly extraordinary. Thanks to your generosity, the school raised (in gifts and pledges) nearly \$1,400,000 this past fiscal year, with \$366,000 contributed to our Annual Fund and donations and pledges of over \$900,000 for the endowment fund.

For those interested in statistics, the list below reflects how significantly The LP outperforms its peers, based on data compiled by the National Association of Independent Schools (NAIS) from all reporting independent elementary schools. In the 2022-2023 fiscal year:

- The LP raised \$3,053 per student, as compared to the \$928 median amount raised per student for all independent elementary schools reporting to NAIS.
- 14% of LP alumni supported the school with financial gifts, as compared to the NAIS average of 4%.
- Current LP parents participated at a rate of 97%, as compared to the NAIS average of 85%.
- Alumni LP parent participation was 30%, as compared to the NAIS average of 11%.

The LP is possible only because of your generous support and the dedicated work of so many, in our classrooms, on the Board, and as volunteers. Our grateful thanks to you all. And with our cherished memories of The LP's "first 50," we continue on the path ahead with fresh energy and commitment.




Read-a-thon 2023






Elementary Schools







On May 9, 2023, Justin Hajj announced the renaming of the school's endowment. Below is an abridged version of his words:

The 50th Anniversary Gala on May 20th marked a very special occasion for our entire community. It was the first opportunity, in person, to celebrate the McCords and their legacy following their retirement. While this gathering was meant to honor the school, it was, simultaneously, our opportunity to celebrate our founders.

There was much discussion regarding how we could send the McCords off in style, and how best to commemorate all of the hard work, dedication, and love that they have poured into The Learning Project. The Gala Committee, in conjunction with the Board of Trustees, decided that the most powerful way to do so is to ensure that the McCords' vision for the school, and its Mission, lives on for generations to come. Therefore, The Learning Project renamed the school's endowment after our founders, and it will, henceforth, be called the 'McCord Mission Fund.'

The McCords envisioned a small city school that maintained accessibility for all. They envisioned a place that offered excellence in academics and character education, and employed dedicated, creative faculty and staff that carried the Mission forward in their hearts. This vision continues to guide us forward, but like all independent schools of our time, The LP is experiencing rising costs, putting pressure on our fundamental goals. It is critical that the school maintain its longstanding commitment to top faculty and staff salaries, maximizing recruiting and retention. The McCord Mission Fund will help to ensure that the school is able to do so, while also upholding the school's longstanding commitment to relatively low tuition and high financial assistance, and continuing to offer an exceptional academic program for its children now and into the future.

We could think of no better way to provide a 'retirement gift' to the McCords than to support their work in the school's first fifty years by creating a solid foundation for the next fifty. Thank you, as always, for your generous support of our special school.
