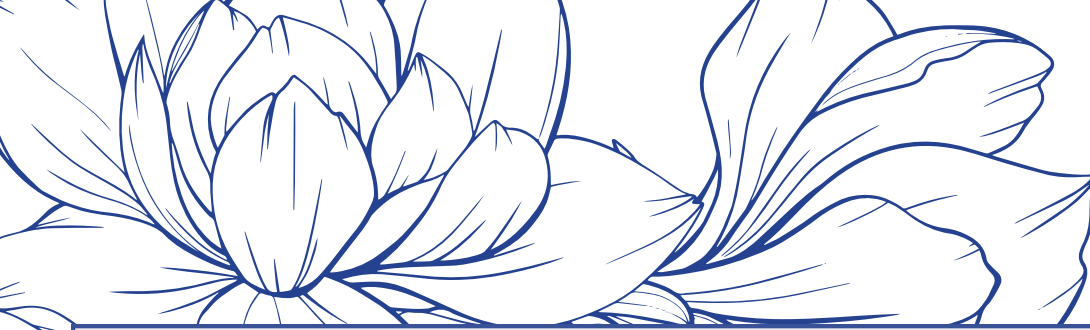

This has been a big year in the life of our little school! As longtime friends of The Learning Project know, the school has long sought a permanent home for our Kindergarten classroom, along with more “elbow room” for our dynamic and thriving art, music, and science programs. This past summer, the City of Boston approved our request to be allowed to use our recently acquired building at 263 Clarendon Street as the second LP campus. Which means that for the first time in a long time, our school is—physically—growing!

Of course, growth is nothing new to The LP. Nurturing our children’s growth is at the core of what The LP does. As our Mission Statement puts it: “We endeavor to build on each child’s inherent curiosity and profound desire to succeed, and to be a place where the cognitive, aesthetic, social, emotional, physical, and moral aspects of life are nurtured.” Every day, when children walk in through the doors of The Learning Project, they are full of extraordinary potential. And every day, when they walk out, our hope is that they have grown academically, socially, emotionally, empathetically, and morally, through their interactions with their fellow students and with our extraordinary faculty and staff.

Nurturing this kind of growth takes time, patience, care, and, of course, resources. The Learning Project has been exceptionally fortunate to have a community of friends willing to provide those resources year after year. This past year, we met our increased Annual Fund goal, raising just over \$443,000. Taking all of our fundraising efforts combined, the school raised \$704,000 in Fiscal Year 2025—a truly astounding amount, reflective of an incredibly generous group of supporters. (That is you! Thank you!!) Your help allows us to meet our longstanding commitment to compensate our unparalleled faculty and staff fairly, to meet the financial needs of our families through robust financial assistance, and to ensure that all LP children have what they need to grow.

On behalf of the trustees, the faculty, the staff, the students, their families, and the entire community—thank you for all that you have done and will continue to do in support of The Learning Project.

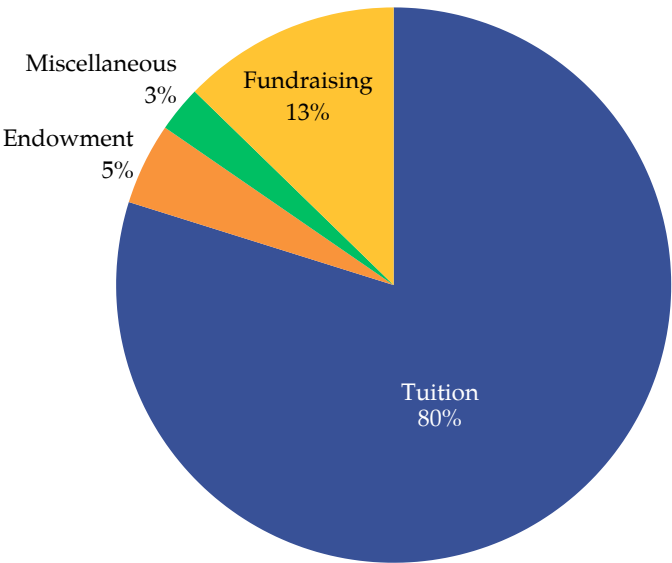

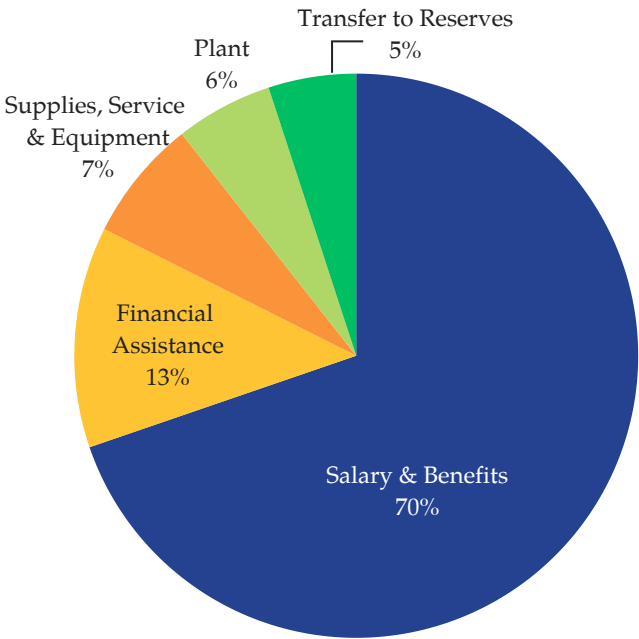

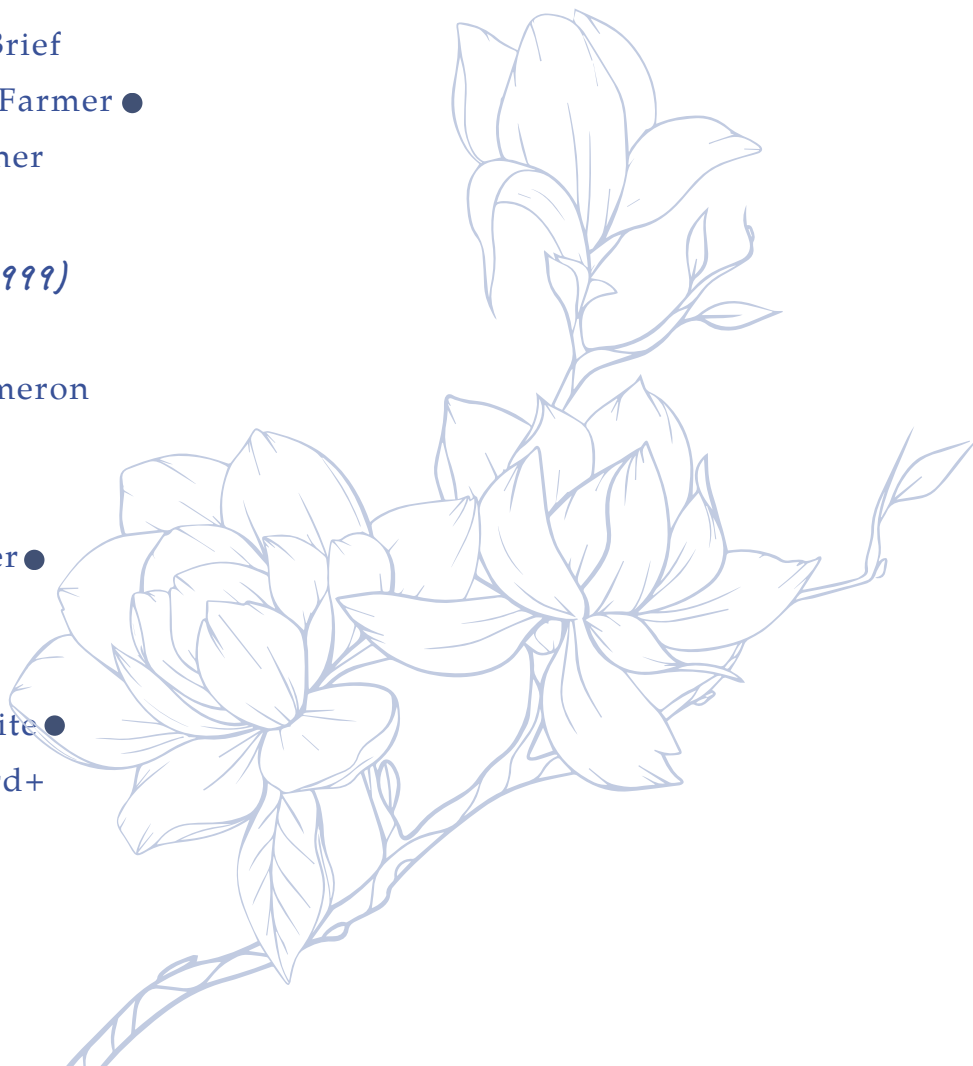
